

# WHAT IS AN OVERRIDE? |

Overrides provide additional funding to support what happens inside school classrooms (teaching, learning and operations). Florence Unified School District hopes to pass a maintenance and operations override (M&O) which will support things such as teacher salaries, benefits, supplies and general operations.

## SAFETY

- Hiring School Resource Officers (SRO) & Mental Health Professionals at each school site.
- Provide campus security with trained professionals.
- Implement a law-based, educational curriculum.

## SERVICES

- Additional teachers to REDUCE CLASS SIZES.
- Advanced programs & services for Gifted Students & students with special needs.
- Hire and retain highly-qualified teachers.
- Provide more specialists to support staff and students.

## SUPPORT

- Add a behavioral and mental health provider for each school.
- Licensed counselors and social workers at each school.
- Provide additional curriculum and instructional resources.

The cost of the proposed override to a household with the average assessed value within the district is estimated to be \$222.11 per year, or **\$0.61 per day**. The estimated tax rate per \$100 of net assessed valuation is \$1.94.
